June 2016 – Recommendations

- **June 27:** Levy Millage Committee meets from 7:30-9:30 am* – Recommend options for millage for possible operating levy, bond issue for deferred maintenance, and permanent improvement levy for ongoing capital needs; could also include additional millage for the facilities plan
- **June 30:** Special meeting of the School Board at 8:00 am:
 - To adopt Fiscal Year 2017 Budget (new budget goes into effect July 1, 2016);
 - Could adopt recommendations from Facilities Master Plan Ad Hoc Committee; and
 - Decide whether there will be a ballot issue and, if so, the content and amount

July and August 2016 – Deadlines

- **July 21:** Special meeting of the School Board to finalize November 8 ballot issue
- **July 11:** Deadline for school district to file State School Consent Form with the Ohio Department of Education and the State Tax Commissioner if there is a bond issue for November 8, 2016 ballot
- **August 10:** Deadline for filing with Franklin County Board of Elections the amount of millage for an operating and/or permanent improvement and/or facility levy for November 8, 2016 election
- **August 24:** First day of school

October and November 2016

- **October 12:** Early Voting and Absentee Voting begin
- **November 8:** General Election
